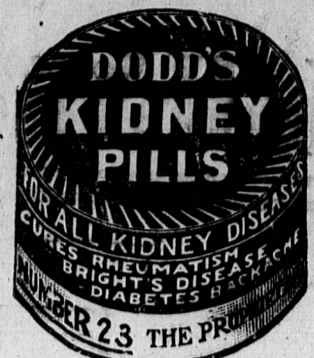
The latest news, first of all.

"Moths of Society" received its premiere at The Castle Square Theatre Boston and the press of that city were unanimous in their praise of Cecil Kingstone's play.
