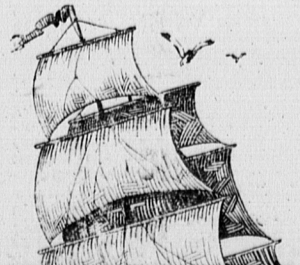

### That Car Of Yours

 Smart-to-Heart Talks With Automobile Owners and Drivers on How to Get the Most Out of Their Cars at the Least Expense.

#### Don't Rush Snow Drifts

The temptation to rush a snow drift as the most logical way to get through is almost irresistible, but those who succumb to it frequently find themselves hopelessly stuck. The way to assure oneself of the greatest traction in such a case is to put the car in low or second gear and approach the drift at a moderate pace. Too much speed displaces the snow and wears a track, thereby making it almost impossible to get traction.

#### Oils Weak Anti-freeze

If the only function of an anti-freeze was to guard the cooling system from freezing temperatures the oils which some motorists use would fill the bill adequately. Kerosene, most commonly used, will not freeze when the thermometer is very low, but it has the deficiency of a high boiling point which will permit the engine to operate at a dangerously high temperature. In addition, the fumes given off are highly inflammable and annoying. Further than this, kerosene has a solvent action on rubber and hose connections very seldom can stand up under its continued use.

#### An Optical Illusion

Snow looks soft, and feels soft and perhaps it is for this reason that many motorists drive over snow-filled highways at a pace that places heavy strains on various parts of the car, resulting in a general loosening of units that should fit snugly. A highway on which the snow has been packed unevenly

is much the same as one which is filled with holes, and no careful motorist would think of driving over the latter at a high speed. Why a charge, it never is quite up to not be similarly careful in Winter? It pays.

#### Keep Facings Apart

If the car is to be stored for the Winter, the owner should see to it that the clutch is disengaged. This may be done by pressing it on the floor and bracing it in this position with a piece of wood. In this manner, one is assured that when the car again is put into service the clutch facing will not have stuck.

#### Also Factors in Dilution

Use of the choke is blamed for much of the dilution of the crankcase oil in the Winter, but it is not altogether responsible. Two other important causes, and they are quite general practices, too, are permitting the engine to idle, and driving slowly. The rich mixture upon which the engine is running in cold weather, under these circumstances, permits considerable raw gasoline to seep into the cylinders, and thence to the crankcase.

#### Racing The Lights Is Wrong

One may "get by" with racing the traffic signal lights during the Summer when the pavement is dry and friction between tire and road is excellent for stopping purposes. It's different when the highway is wet or icy. Rushing to make the intersection before the light shifts to red, one may get entirely too much momentum to stop safely in case the signal is victorious in the chase. It is better to play safe.

#### Overcharging Hurts

If the engine refuses to start after a reasonable time; do not continue to step on the starter. The chances are that the battery is low, and continual use of the starter results in overdischarging. The re-

#### TO JAIL MILLIONAIRE IN FALL-SINCLAIR CONSPIRACY

WASHINGTON, Nov. 8.—A warrant was issued to-day for Harry F. Sinclair, millionaire oil man, charged with jury tampering, in the Fall-Sinclair conspiracy trial.

After a warrant had been sought for A. Mason Day, Sinclair's alleged "go-between" in engaging detectives to shadow Fall-Sinclair jurors, Day was taken before United States Commissioner Turnage, pleaded not guilty to jury tampering charges, and was held under bond.

#### USE OF DETECTIVES

The warrant application charged employment of detectives to attempt to influence the jurors' action and decision.

The warrant for Sinclair climaxed the Governor's efforts to link him directly with the groups of Burns detectives who allegedly followed Fall-Sinclair jurors during the recent trial. The Government felt that it had achieved this task sufficiently to warrant this serious action against the wealthy oil defendant.
