Gardiner Comments On Meat Situation

Canadians Eating Less Meat Per Capita Than Americans.

OTTAWA, March 27 - (CP) - Canada can ship more meat to Britain by keeping Canadian packing plants busy than by shipping meat to the United States for processing.

At the time of peak delivery of cattle last fall the Canadian Government had approached United States Government officials in Washington and had gone directly to St. Paul, Minn., packing plants suggesting a quantity of Canadian cattle should be shipped to St. Paul for processing but the proposal was turned down.

all, I think, in the United States and Canada, as well as in Great Britain," Mr. Gardiner said, "that it has been the united wish of all three that as possible a surplus of surplus meat, not only from Canada but from this continent, should be sent to Great Britain or to other countries requiring it, particularly in these days when other countries are being occupied by the Allied forces."

"We have been co-operating to the greatest extent possible in making the largest amounts available from this country for shipment directly to Great Britain. That has been understood by the representatives of all three governments. The matter is still under consideration and discussion, even more so now than it was last fall."
