Lifford defeats Maine boxer

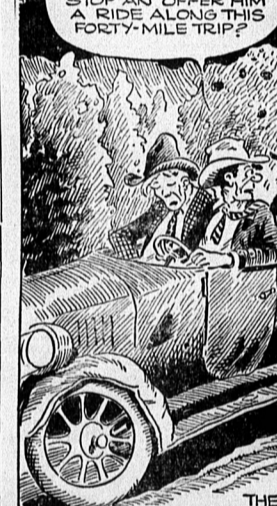
