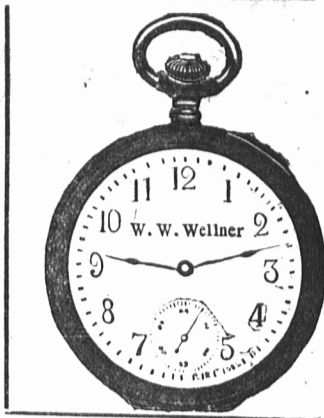

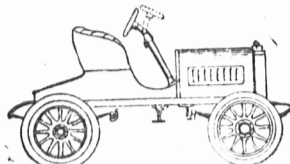

FLEXIBLE HANDLE BAR.

The disposal of the steering wheel of the automobile has been a matter which has troubled the builders of the smaller vehicles for some time. In order to be in convenient position for the chauffeur, the location of the wheel is necessarily at a point where it is a considerable bother to persons entering and leaving the vehicle. Various schemes have been resorted to with the idea of overcoming this inconvenience. In some models the steering rod has been made with a joint so that when the passengers are alighting or entering the vehicle the steering wheel can be swung out of the way. Detachable handle bars have been made also for the same purpose. The very latest thing in this line is the adoption of a flexible shaft for this purpose. The links of the flexible shaft are contained in a tube which is rigidly fitted into the floor of the carriage and near the top there is a curve in the tube by which the wheel is maintained in a position entirely convenient to the chauffeur while he is engaged in guiding the vehicle over the roads. Later when he desires to take on or put off passengers, the tube is given a turn by means of a handle which is fastened to it at a convenient point, and this operation turns the wheel entirely out of the way.
