In the illustration a very clever effect is achieved with a coat of the Directoire period, and a plain full skirt of a silky white shawl. The coat is in printed tulle, the back fashioned with the usual complement of seams, and sits up in the centre of the waistline to let the full folds of the skirt show through. The fringes come but half way to the centre, which is filled in with a bodice of white chiffon, shirred down the centre and with handkerchief shaped reverses of lace for a finish at the bust. The coat itself also shows reverses these latter lined with a precious harelith and display the embroidered chiffon facing. The sleeve is a built-out, full and billowy puff that drops into a smart upturned cuff above the elbow. The skirt is one of those new circular cuts, with narrow pleats at the hand, that are not pressed at all and fall in extremely full and swirling folds to the feet. The length is the new round train.
