able developments on the New York market, the assurance should be highly gratifying to the large body of holders, and to the number far beyond these who look upon the C. P. R. as a national institution. For a time the outlook did not appear very promising, as gross earnings this year have been running far behind last year's although by a measurably decreasing amount as the year wore on. The company, however, has been able to cut down considerably the ratio of operation costs to gross income, to such an extent that in October a drop of over \$5,000,000 in gross was absorbed to an extent of more than 70 p.c. or some \$2,000,000. It is always difficult to forecast results in connection with so complicated an organization as a transcontinental railway, but with all allowances it seems reasonable to look forward to a substantial gain in net earnings for the month of November as compared with the corresponding month of last year. The first week in December was even more encouraging in showing an actual increase in gross, so December also may be looked upon as giving promise of adding to November's part in cutting down the decline in net earnings that had accumulated by the end of October.
