BOTTOM FELL FROM THE SEA.

MILAN, July 28.—There was a curious phenomena in southern Italy during the present intense period of earthquake shocks and renewed volcanic activity. Count Getido Biscarretti, commander of the Vittor Pisani warships, with three other torpedo vessels, was engaged in firing practice in the Gulf of Salerno, when the sea suddenly began to sink at so amazing a rate that he was constrained to weigh anchor and steam 300 yards away. The disturbance seemed almost immediately under the feet. The remarkable phenomenon was witnessed also by Admiral Corsi and various crews. It was quite unique in their experience. The sea continued to go down for a full quarter of an hour, then returning to its normal level, but after a while the whole thing rehappened. At Cap Taiaity, of the Naples port, the same phenomenon was observed for over two hours, also at Messina.

was taken in the meeting of the British Medical Association at Brighton yesterday, when Sir Berkeley Moynihan, professor of clinical surgery in the University of Leeds, described the discovery by the American surgeon, George W. Crile, of Chili, Ohio, of a method of anaesthesia whereby the area of operation could be shut off from the brain for several days if necessary.
