attractions so long as a feeling of undue rivalry does not arise too conspicuously and the spirit of animosity enter in. Music is something that every person likes, and a nightly program of music and singing is a good attraction. Let all do their best, and use the methods that suit best your division then it will occupy an important position in your community.

During the past quarter I may say that I have had an unusually large amount of correspondence as the result of numerous enquiries from our sister Provinces as to the success and working of our present Provincial Prohibitory Law. It would appear that our neighboring provinces are anxious to secure such temperance legislation as would put them on equal basis with little P.E.I. That they will yet succeed is evident. The tide has already turned in their favor. The pulpit and press has declared against the enemy as never before. Bro. F. S. Spence declares that today a great temperance wave is sweeping Ontario and that before many years victory will perch upon their banners.

GENERAL BENEFITS OF PROHIBITION.

The beneficial results of prohibition as opposed to license or regulation are undeniable. Let our friends should forget, it may not be amiss again to enumerate some of these advantages. They will bear inspection:—

1st. Prohibition expresses the state's disapproval of a regulation of the traffic and brands it with disgrace.

2nd. It decreases the population of the jails and poor houses, and cemeteries, and increases that of the schools and churches.

3rd. It diverts the millions of money wasted in drink into legitimate channels of trade and thus promotes the welfare and prosperity of the province.

4th. It relieves the state of the sin and responsibility of turning its sober children into drunkards for a money consideration.

Let us be thankful that we are gaining some experimental knowledge of those advantages under the working of our splendid prohibitory law.

As a Grand Division we are justly proud of our Prohibitory law, and of the fact that the moral sentiment of the province was strong enough to call it into existence. Geographically we are not large. We do not occupy much space on the map, but we are proud of the fact that from the standpoint of temperance legislation, we are leading the van.

And whereas conventions are held today to discuss the great problem of temperance, little P.E.I. and its strong and well entrenched Prohibitory law is always fittingly referred to as PROVINCIAL TEMPERANCE ALLIANCE.

One of the most important items of the past quarter has been the annual meeting of the Provincial Temperance Alliance, which met in the Y.M.C.A. rooms Charlottetown on Tuesday March 31st ult. Two very enthusiastic and representative sessions were held. We would here wish to express our heartfelt commendation of the following resolutions passed:—

1st "That this Alliance is of the opinion that one inspector in each county would be more in the interest of Temperance work provided a sufficient salary be given to enable them to devote their whole time in the work."

2nd "In view of the gross abuse of the law on the part of many doctors in giving prescriptions for pro-ferably medical purposes the inspectors are strongly urged to put the law in force wherever there are plain cases of its violation."

3rd That the Government's attention be and is hereby called to section 10 of the "Act to impose a direct tax on Commercial Travellers" which permits under license of \$200 travellers coming into the Province for the sale of liquors against the spirit and intent of the Provincial

Prohibition Act." It is to us a matter of very gratifying import to know and realize that our Provincial Alliance representing as it does the best interests of our province, has so assumed such a defiant and determined stand toward the better enforcement of our Prohibitory Law as well as the total annihilation of the common enemy of our people. We are also pleased to learn that our new Premier Hon. Mr. Hazard has vouchsafed to us as by his predecessor all needed support in the matter of temperance legislation.

SIXTIETH ANNIVERSARY

I would here wish to remind, this Grand Division that our sixtieth anniversary of the birth of the Grand Division in this province takes place on Oct. 23rd next. Our Grand Division by arrangement meets about that time in annual session with Shamrock Division at Kensington. I would suggest that this Grand Division assembled today appoint a special committee to take into consideration the advisability of holding a formal celebration on the date above mentioned. The said committee to report at our next July session.

WORLD'S TEMPERANCE CONGRESS.

I also wish to intimate here that the World's Temperance Congress in commemoration of the organization of the first Temperance Society by Dr. Billy J. Clarke, who one hundred years ago set in motion influences which resulted in the formation of the first temperance society in Modern History is to be held at Saratoga Springs, N.Y. beginning June 14-23, the session of the National Division will also be held during the earlier days in the Congress making the occasion one of more than usual interest. An invitation has already been sent to all nations of the world to send representatives to the Congress. One of the interesting features of the Congress will be an excursion to the old home of Dr. Billy J. Clarke, and the unveiling of a Tablet, with appropriate ceremonies, to mark the spot where the first Temperance Society was founded.
