REGULATED IN THE INTERESTS OF QUEBEC.

In his speech on the draft address at the recent opening of the Quebec Legislature Premier Gouin said: "The annexation of Ungava will be regulated in the interests of Quebec, just as the increased subsidies had been arranged."

But these congratulations are not of the sort upon which the Maritime Provinces or their leaders can felicitate themselves. They have gained nothing in area, or lands, or forests, or mines or fisheries, or in prestige or glory or honor.

As every intelligent Canadian knows Quebec is the pivot Province, and her population as determined by each succeeding census is the measure by which our representation at Ottawa is to be governed.

THE INTERRUPTION OF THE WINTER STEAMERS.

It is the unexpected that happens. A week or more ago the demand became strenuous that the winter steamers should come direct to Charlottetown.

There is no blame to the captains or the agent for what has happened. The blame rests wholly with the Ottawa authorities who have for a generation past both neglected and refused to take any adequate or reasonable steps to provide the efficient and continuous communication which the Dominion is bound by solemn compact to supply.

The staple facts of the case are that against heavy ice and a northeast wind the steamers are powerless. For a time the delusion was cherished that a more powerful boat than the Stanley would do better in such emergencies than our first winter boat.

We have had an exceptionally mild winter, and the boats have done their work fairly well, under the favorable conditions existing. There is little reason to believe that the new steamer now being built will accomplish anything better in the worst of a bad

Doubtless some man will say, "No blame to Quebec or to Premier Gouin for taking what comes in their way." "There's not to reason why," especially if no one—that is no Government representing a Maritime Province—has in any pronounced official way objected.

Does some one say Ungava is far north and therefore valueless? Let the story of Alaska furnish the answer. Or better still take a glance at the map of Russia. There you will see St. Petersburg, with a million inhabitants, capital of the Great Russian Empire, located on the 60th parallel of north latitude.
