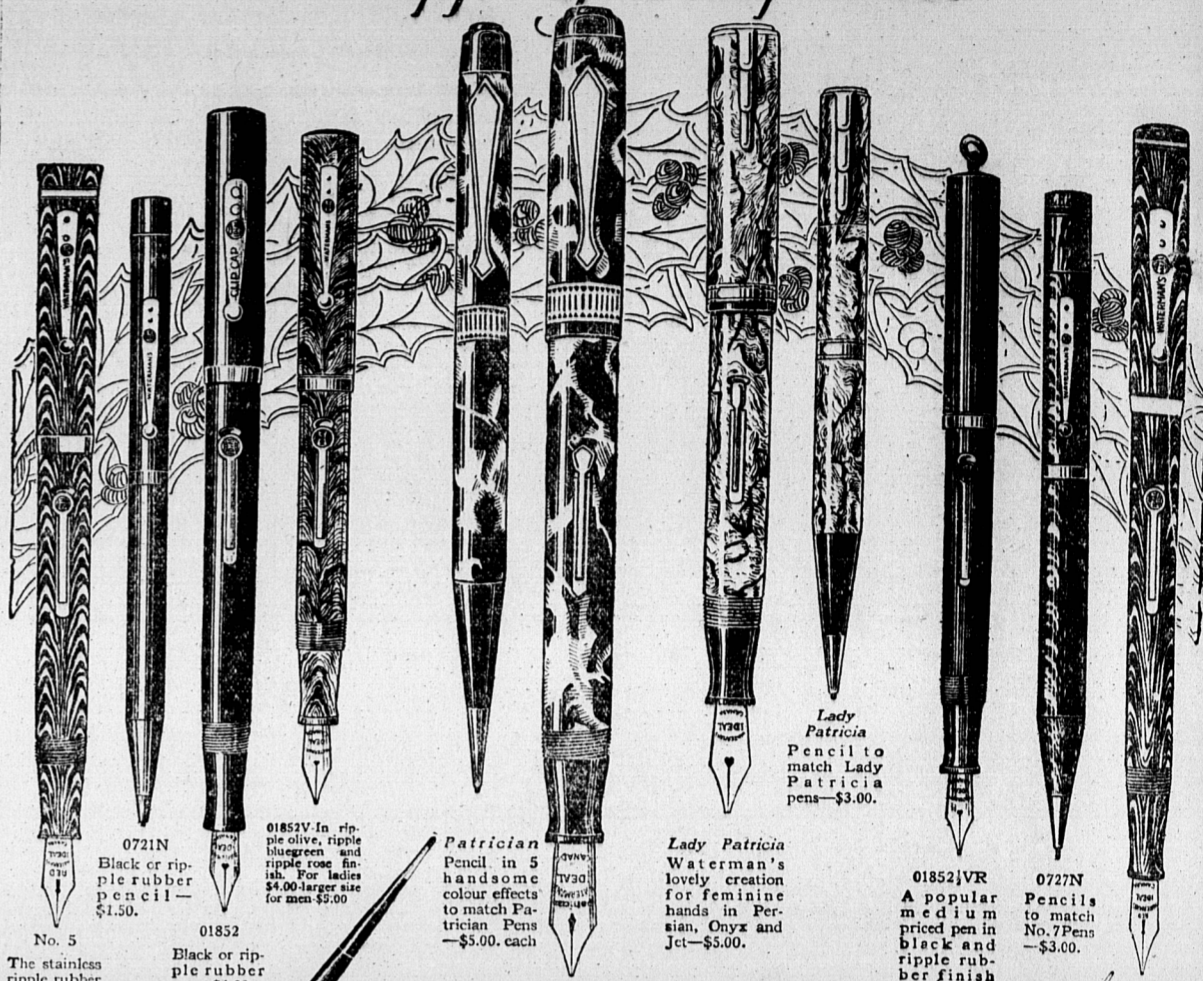

CANADA'S NEW DESTROYERS TO BE DELIVERED IN SPRING

OTTAWA, Dec. 16.—Delivery of Canada's two new destroyers, Saguenay and Skeena, will be made next Spring. The former will be ready about the end of March, and the latter four weeks later. The two warships will make the transatlantic voyage in consort, and the probabilities are they will traverse the northern route to this country.

When the present vessels now serving at Canadian stations, Champlain and Vancouver, crossed the ocean, they did so via the Azores and Bermuda. The new ships have a wider cruising radius, however, and can stay at sea much longer without refueling.

THE DROP IN SILVER

NEW YORK, Dec. 16.—Just when bullion dealers were inclined to believe that the worst was about over in the silver market, prices for the metal here and in London broke sharply to the lowest levels in the history of the market.

Heavy selling of the metal in China, where stocks although not near the peak, are substantial, and steadily increasing stocks in the hands of the Indian Government, preclude, it is said any substantial recovery in the market at this moment. If popular gossip is to be believed, the price movement in silver presages changes in other commodity prices, but, according to the best opinion on the subject, such gossip is given far more consideration than it actually merits.

Forest Products Investigation The Forest Products Laboratories of the Forest Service, Department of the Interior, have for some years been making a study of the commodity of glue in line with researches carried on in all progressive industrial countries. The experimental

work includes the fixing of Canadian standards; test for making improvements in glues used by paper-box manufacturers; investigation of glues composed of vegetable casing; detection and elimination of harmful; and the improvement of water-resistant quantities.
