### THE EDITOR'S MAIL.

#### Mr. Tanton Explains.

SIR.—In your notes of Saturday's trial you make several statements not consistent with facts. The non-suit was made not because there was "no evidence" of negligence but because, as stated by the Judge, the evidence was "slim" and not strong enough to warrant him awarding damages. I was not aware of any rule of law requiring a particular strength of evidence to put a man on his defence if once a case is established.

Nor is it correct that Mr. Boswell's horse was frightened by horses reeling behind him. I had evidence at hand to effectually settle such a contention if made and also other evidences of negligence which in the natural order of trials could only be offered after the defence had closed their case and those witnesses are shut off by non-suit.

It would be a sad reflection upon law and order if any person could take a young untrained colt upon a public park where hundreds of our people congregate and leisurely allowing his reins out of his control to cause destruction of property and danger to human life without being called upon to pay at least a portion of the cost of his escapade. But the end is not yet.

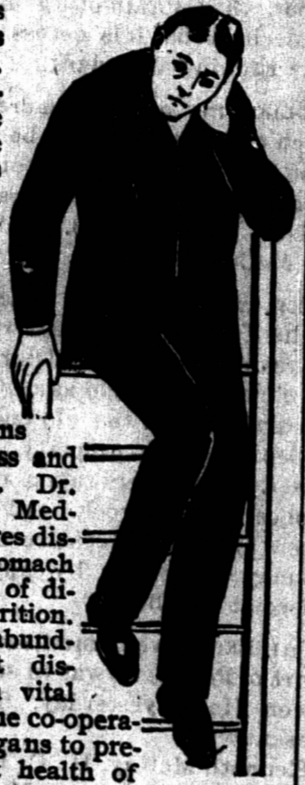
