LONDON, Jan. 9.—Stories of the peculiar adventures which have befallen royalties or men of distinction when travelling incognito may be counted by the thousand.

There have been and are living to-day at least a dozen royalties who can boast of the experience of having received a tip.

The Emperor Francis Joseph, of Austria, perhaps has the premier claim to this distinction. The rather rustic simplicity of the Emperor's attire when at Fiume, the one time the care of state and the turbulence of Austria-Hungary, had frequently exposed him to the most ludicrous errors in identity. It happened one day that the Emperor, dressed only in a rusty suit of alpaca, a straw hat, and a pair of worn, saw an unruly horse, who, in a burst of wild enthusiasm, was kicking to pieces the dashboard of the carriage to which he was attached and threatening danger to everybody within reach.

Francis Joseph, an old cavalryman, seeing at a glance where the trouble lay, quietly went up to the horse, and with the skill of a master, brought the horse to submission.

"Good for you, old man," said the driver, leaning down and giving the Emperor a friendly little pat on the shoulder. "Here is a florin for your trouble." With a grateful smile did the Emperor take the florin. Then he turned and gave his horse a look which might have exhibited the florin as evidence of how much may be accomplished by honest industry.

The Archduke Joseph has even a better story on the same line. Walking in the grounds of his castle, about twenty miles from Vienna, he was approached by a tourist who requested first permission to enter the castle. "With the greatest pleasure," said the Archduke. "If you will permit me I will act as guide." Then he led the tourist through various apartments, carefully describing everything of interest.

"You are the best and most intelligent guide I ever met," said the tourist with huge pomposity, and well worth these two florins.

## O'BRIEN AND THE IRISH PARTY

DUBLIN, Jan. 9.—John E. Redmond, chairman of the Irish parliamentary party to-day issued a statement in explanation of the proceedings at the conference recently held for the purpose of bringing about the reconciliation of William O'Brien, Nationalist member of parliament for Cork, and the Irish.

A reconciliation has not yet been effected, as Mr. O'Brien, demanded the immediate summoning of a national convention on a new basis of representation, which Mr. Redmond declined to accede, and in his present statement the Irish leader contends that the acceptance of Mr. O'Brien's demands by the directorate would be tantamount to surrendering their own chairman and abdicating further that the campaign for an immediate convention is not one for unity, but for strife.
