## R. G. INGERSOLL AND SPIRIT WORLD

NEW YORK, Sept. 15.—Because on the eve of his death Robert G. Ingersoll, the great agnostic, promised her if there was a spirit world he would endeavor to communicate with her, Mrs. Ingersoll, at her home in Dobbs Ferry, is seeking his spirit.

"If a world of spirits exists," said Ingersoll, as he lay on his deathbed, "and it is possible for a spirit to establish communication between that world and this, I will try to establish communication with you."

"If spirits exist I believe that my Husband will seek me out. I am trying to aid it," said Mrs. Ingersoll, adding that only after communication had been established would she give credit to the Christian belief in a hereafter.

"I am not a spiritualist, and I do not know that there are spirits," she said, "but I must have the most positive communication. The words, or message must deal with subjects known only to myself and my husband."

"Before I will admit the reality of the spirit, it must go over me with the period between our betrothal and our marriage. If that can be done, I will admit a hereafter and a spirit world."

"I have a woman friend who is a medium. She appears to have unusual powers. Yet many others who displayed strange powers before my husband and myself—one was the noted Slade—were afterwards exposed as fakirs. And so—I have no firm opinion."

"It would be great comfort to me to be sure that his spirit was waiting for mine to join it and also to believe that in the spirit world he was continuing the activities of which I was so proud in this life."

Mr. Ingersoll died in 1899.
