HOUSEHOLD HINTS

PUTTY IS VITAL FOR FINE FINISH

Putty is too often thought of as being only incidental to more important surface finishes, but its real value should not be underestimated.

The better grades of putty are compounded of linseed oil and whiting. The poorer grades are made of marble dust and mineral lights.

Before applying putty to wood it is advisable to go over the wood with a thin coat of paint. This will prevent absorption of the oil from the putty by the porous wood.

Remove dust by rubbing with soft tissue paper, and clean by rubbing lightly with a soft linseed-oil-rubber. Piano Keys—Rub with a cloth wrung out in equal parts of vinegar and water.

Carpets—Clean with a reliable carpet soap, and if possible lay out on the lawn to dry and air. Sprinkle special moth preventive powder underneath carpets when relaying.

Polished Furniture—Clean away finger marks and previous applications of polish by wiping with a cloth wrung out in a weak solution of vinegar and water.

Wax Paper—Slightly soiled wallpaper may be cleaned by rubbing with a piece of new leaf or there is a special wax-like preparation which on being rubbed over the surface will freshen and remove marks.
