TORONTO, July 27 — (CP) — All indices closed on the down side of the Toronto Stock Exchange today. The golds dropped 32, the Base Metals 18 and the Western Oil -08.

WINNIPEG, July 27 — (CP) — Wheat purchases by the United Kingdom included 200,000 bushels of No. 1 northern today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange.

MONTREAL, July 27 — (CP) — Majority of changes were on the downside in transfers today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market though in closing deals a number of issues showed decreases or cut their losses.

NEW YORK, July 27 — (AP) — Quiet and selective demand remained in the Stock Market today although many leaders failed to attract worthwhile bids. The Associated Press 80 stock average was unchanged at 54.8 for the second consecutive session.

LONDON, July 27 — (CP) — Profit taking in stocks continued throughout the session but the greater part of it was well absorbed and losses were confined to narrow limits. Industrial shares finished easier and home rails mostly were steady. O.T. declined. Kafirs showed little activity while diamond shares were pressing supporting orders from Cape Town.

CHICAGO, July 27 — (AP) — The commercial demand for wheat futures tapered off in late trading today and prices dropped fractions from the day's best figures under the pressure of scattered selling, some of which was regarded as hedging. The rice market was nervous, prices breaking under moderate selling after short covering had been completed and quotations had advanced a cent or more.
