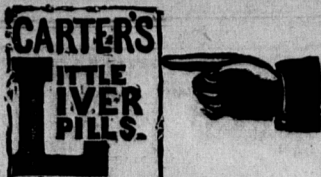

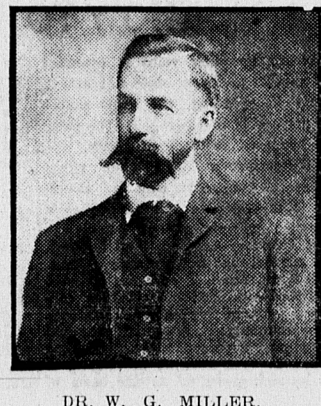

He has been making a study of disease in tropical climates and recently delivered a lecture in which he claims that medicine triumphed over the deadly fevers.



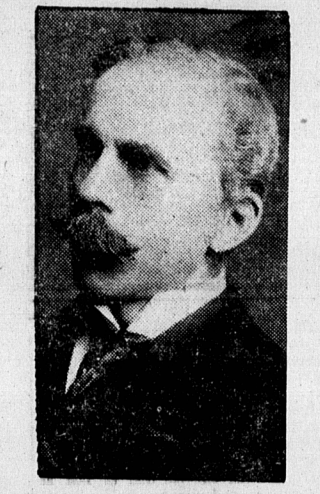
HON. A. G. RUTHERFORD.
He was returned to power again at the general election in Alberta a few days ago.



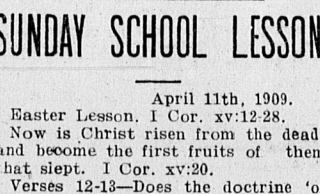
DR. W. G. MILLER.

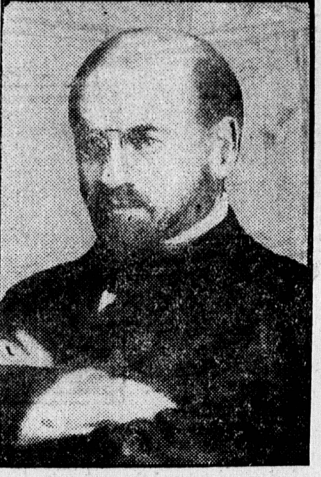
DR. FRANK VON ADAMS.
