Governor of the Cape.

Sir Walter Hely-Hutchinson, Governor of the Cape, was educated at Harrow and Cambridge, and called to the Bar at the Inner Temple. He went out to Australia as private secretary to Sir Hercules Robinson (afterwards Lord Rosmead), then Governor of New South Wales. One of his first duties was to accompany Sir Hercules to Fiji, whose ruler, the ex-annihil King Thakombau, had decided to cede that Pacific group to Queen Victoria. Sir Hercules added the islands to the British dominions in her Majesty's name, but all the details and correspondence were carried out by his private secretary, Sir Walter was promoted to the West Indies, afterwards to Malta, and ten years ago to South Africa as Governor of Natal. That was a post of difficulty and danger at the outset of the late war, and if the Boers had not stopped to besiege Ladysmith, there is no telling what might have happened to Natal and its Governor. Two years ago, when Lord Milner decided to concentrate his energies on the work of administration and reorganization in the Transvaal and the Orange River Colony, Sir Walter was promoted from Natal to the Cape.
