## LIQUOR IN ELECTIONS.

Notwithstanding the strong temperance sentiment prevalent in this Province, the restrictive laws and energetic efforts to enforce them, experience has proved that in our federal, provincial and civic elections liquor has been used to a regrettable extent. There is a baneful affinity between elections and liquor. In the larger elections the supporters of both parties have used liquor to their mutual discredit, each party charging that the other party was making use of liquor and that it was necessary to offset it by like unlawful acts in order to make things even. In civic affairs party influences are not so active but the liquor interest has always had a keen desire to secure the election of certain persons to the Council Board and has invariably resorted to corrupt treating to further that end.

From information received we have reason to fear a resort to like disgraceful tactics at the coming civic election. We mention the fact in order that the Prosecutor and officers of the law may be more than usually alert to detect and bring to justice any who may offend in this way. We believe that this will be

done and the full penalty of \$100 exacted in every discovered case of treating on election day. We have had in the City marked sobriety and order during the year that is past. This is greatly to the credit of the City and to all concerned in the administration of the law. Let us have a sober, honest election, free from corrupt and corrupting influences, and may the best men win!

## A CIVIC EXAMPLE.

At a recent town election in Yarmouth one Dr. Perrin acting as he said without solicitation from any one, and to the great surprise of many, issued his card to the electors. He stated frankly that he believed he was unjustly taxed; that the town officers received too much pay for the work done; that expenditures for the services were too large; that the members of Council were too well agreed and that opposition was necessary. He added that he would not solicit a vote, nor give a glass of liquor nor carry a voter to the polls, and if by any chance he should be elected he would be astounded. And he must have been astounded for he led the poll in every polling division. He did not expect to be elected and yet proved to be the most popular candidate before the people.

Next year Prince Edward Island will have four Rhodes scholars at Oxford. If Canada could only keep pace with us—which it cannot—the Dominion would have two hundred bright young men at Oxford.

A great captain of industry has fallen by the death of E. B. Eddy, of Ottawa. Mr. Eddy was born in the United States and came to Bytown as a young man with only half a dollar in his pocket. But his industry, energy and enterprise were great. He saw the possibilities of the great waterpower of Chaudiere Falls, and proceeded to exploit them. He lived to develop one of the greatest lumber mills on earth. He added the manufacture of matches, and developed this industry until it made his name famous. In later years a company bearing his name took up the manufacture of paper upon an extended scale and with great success. Much of the rapid growth of Ottawa was due to the industries set on foot by Mr. Eddy, and with which he was connected down to his death.
