Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family and is over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister in certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along with his homestead. Price \$100 per acre. Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead rights and can obtain a pre-emption, may pre-empt a quarter-section of land in certain districts. Price \$300 per acre. Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. Price \$500 per acre.
