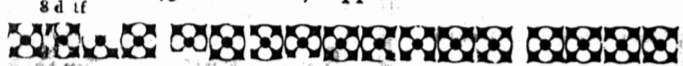

THE MARKETS.

There was a small market yesterday, both in attendance and produce for sale. There was a slight drop in the price of poultry. Geese sold from 9 to 11 cents per lb, turkeys from 13 to 14 cents, and chickens 7 to 8 cents.

Eggs brought 25c per doz, and butter sold at from 22 to 24c per lb.

Owing to the small quantity of hay in the market the price ranged from 70 to 80 cents per cwt. The price of oats and potatoes remained the same as the previous market.

Pork sold from 51 to 52 cents per lb.

NEW POSTAL CONVENTION.

OTTAWA, December 23.—The post office department has issued a circular explanatory of the new postal convention between Canada and Mexico, which takes effect on January 1st next. Mail matter of first, second and third classes, newspapers, samples of merchandise and printed and miscellaneous matter may be sent to Mexico at the same rates as to Canadian points. Articles of merchandise which pass as fourth class matter in Canada will have to be sent to Mexico by parcel post.
