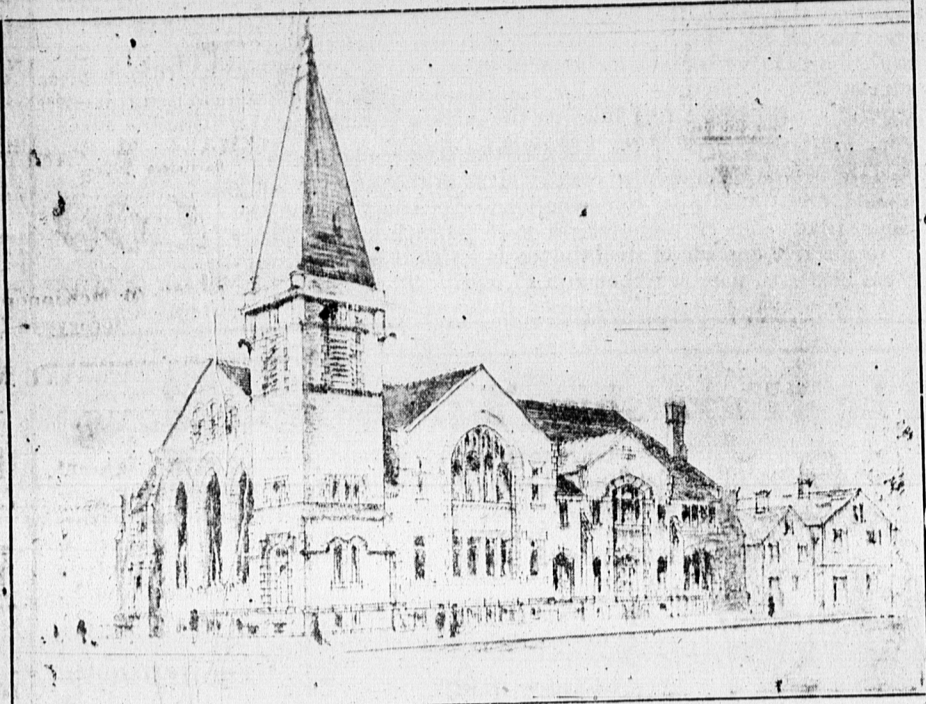


DESCRIPTION OF THE NEW ZION CHURCH FOR THIS CITY--WILL BE A MAGNIFICENT AND IMPOSING STRUCTURE

A part of Charlottetown has been disappearing during the past two weeks, but there are few citizens who regard with regret the demolition of the old buildings on the corner of Grafton and Prince Streets, for they long ago had outgrown their usefulness and had become an eye sore in what is a very fine quarter of the city. Some few years ago Zion

examination of the plans shows that in its interior arrangements and appointments the new Zion will be as convenient and beautiful as it is imposing in its exterior appearance. The architecture of the church is of a modified gothic style, with large windows which guarantee an abundance of light. The walls will be of Annapolis brick, with trimmings of

two parts, the Upper Prince St. end being used for the Sabbath School and the main part facing Grafton and Prince Sts. for the auditorium. Nova Scotia grey-stone. The roof will be slated. The walls of the tower are carried up square to a height of sixty feet, surmounted by a spire of forty feet, making the apex of the spire one hundred feet from the ground. A bell-chamber is provided in the tower in case the congregation should ever desire to use a bell. The main body of the building extends 124 feet on Prince St., and 76 feet on Grafton St. This in the interior arrangement, is divided into

with elevated floor, ready access to the seats being furnished by five aisles. There are three entrances, one from the tower on the corner, one from Prince St., and the third from Grafton St. This main floor will seat 800, but on the Prince St. side of the auditorium there will be a balcony in the form of a horse shoe seating 200 additional. The pulpit will be on the west side of the church facing Prince St. The organ will be in the rear of the pulpit, but elevated with a slight overhang. The

17,000 FOR A RING TO ESSEX FROM QUEEN ELIZABETH

LONDON, May 18.—Seventeen thousand dollars was paid at today's auction at Christies for the tragical relic known as "the Essex ring" which was given to the Earl of Essex by Queen Elizabeth as a token of her regard and which, according to tradition, was to be returned to the queen if her friend was imperilled. The ring was a simple her protection. When the earl was condemned to death, so the story goes he entrusted the ring for its return to the queen to the countess of Nottingham, who, however, influenced by enemies of the earl, failed to execute her mission. Elizabeth, offended at not receiving a plea for mercy from the earl, permitted him to suffer the penalty of death. The ring has since been in the possession of the descendants of the Earl of Essex, and was sold by the executors of Lord John Thane.

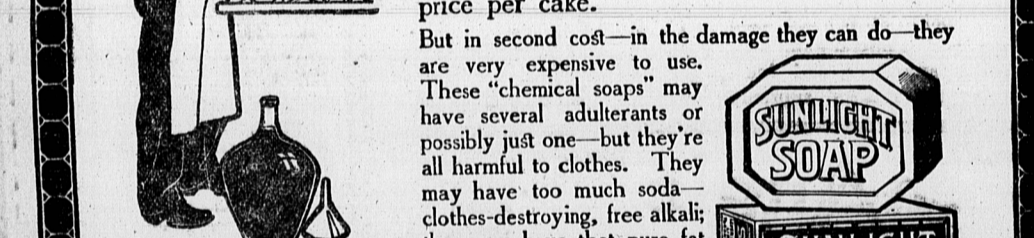
