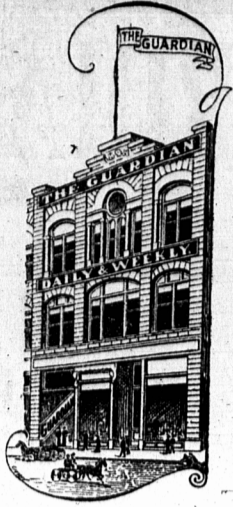

THE PORT ARTHUR SIEGE.

General Stoessel is winning the admiration of military men all over the world by his heroic defence of Port Arthur against greatly superior force. He has fully sustained the hopes of his countrymen and has undoubtedly greatly disappointed his enemies. The time was when it was given out at Tokio that "the fall" was expected by July 15. All through August the end of the siege was looked for as liable to happen almost any day.

We have at hand the guesses as to the dates of the fall of Port Arthur made about the middle of that month by half a dozen citizens who were following the war news closely, and these guesses ranged over various near dates of which 22nd August and 1st September were the extremes. Since then expectation has been often met by disappointment. September and October came and went and then we were told that the final assault and capture were to signalise the Mikado's birthday, November 3. Later still Baron Hayashi, the Japanese Minister in London, a very conservative authority, expressed his hope that the fall of Port Arthur would be announced by the 15th.

At the present few will hazard a guess as to the future duration of the siege. The inner works of the fortress yet to be captured are immensely strong, and are defended by guns of such range and precision as were never before used to defend a besieged stronghold. The garrison have proved themselves men of heroic courage and endurance, and their commander has evinced the greatest possible resourcefulness and skill. Quite as much if not more can be said of the besieging force and its commander. No one ventures the opinion that a British, an American or a German army could have besieged Port Arthur with greater valor, skill, persistence or success than have been shown by General Nogi and his men.

The siege will live in history as a memorable one. Nor can it be said, since war is what it is, that all the frightful carnage has been in vain, or that Stoessel ought even now to surrender if he can hold out longer. Elliott defended Gibraltar for three years. The men defending Port Arthur are giving their endurance and their lives to hold in check an army of
