and Mr. D. Wright to address the people. Serving of the edict was left in the hands of the interim moderator of Zion session.

Presbytery expressed sympathy with Summerside congregation and with the hope that they may soon have a settled pastor. Mr. R. G. Sinclair was appointed interim moderator of Summerside session and instructed to have the charge declared vacant as soon as possible after the twenty-fifth of December instant. Mr. John Murray was appointed interim moderator of Bequeque session, in place of Mr. R. G. Sinclair, resigned, and Mr. W. H. Spencer was appointed to declare the charge vacant on Sabbath, the eighteenth inst.

The committee appointed to consider the condition of Brookfield and adjacent congregations reported and recommended that these congregations remain as they are at present, and this recommendation was adopted. On motion the following College Fund allocations were made to congregations, namely:

West River and Marshfield, each twenty dollars (\$20.00); Hampton, fifteen dollars (\$15.00); Georgetown, Caledonia, Mount Stewart, Murray Harbour North, Murray Harbour South, Montrose, Woodville, Dundas, Richmond Bay East, each twenty dollars (\$20.00); Covehead, Richmond Bay West, St. Peter's each twenty-five dollars (\$25.00); Alberton, Central, Orwell, Bloomfield, Brookfield, Cavendish, Souris, Montague, Strathalbyn, each thirty dollars (\$30.00); Bequeque, Afton, Valleyfield, each thirty-five dollars (\$35.00); Belfast, forty-five dollars (\$45.00); Kensington, Miramichi, each fifty-five dollars (\$55.00); St. James', Charlottetown, Zion, Charlottetown, Summerside, each sixty dollars (\$60.00).

It was moved, seconded and carried, that the janitor of St. James' Hall be paid the sum of five dollars out of the Presbytery Fund; that the thanks of the Presbytery be tendered to Messrs. T. C. James and D. A. Bruce, for their work in securing entertainment for the members attending this meeting and to the people of Charlottetown for their generous hospitality.

Presbytery then adjourned to meet in Zion Church, Charlottetown, on Thursday, the twenty-ninth of December instant, at half past seven o'clock in the evening, for the induction of Mr. Strathie, of which public intimation was given, and this sederunt was closed with the benediction.

It was moved by Mr. T. F. Fullerton, seconded by Mr. D. Wright, that this Presbytery disapprove of the basis of church union as set down by Presbyteries by the General Assembly under the Barrier Act.

Mr. R. G. Strathie moved in amendment that the word "disapprove" be substituted for the word "disapproves" in the motion. This was seconded by Mr. John Gillis. Discussion on the motion and the amendment continued until half-past five o'clock at which time Presbytery adjourned to meet in the same place at half past seven o'clock in the evening, and to remain in session until the taking of the vote, of which public intimation was given and this sederunt was closed with the benediction.
