Mr. Hughes reviewed Dominion tariff history at some length, criticizing the Bennett Government on the ground of high tariffs...

Mr. John R. MacLean, First Kings, congratulated the Premier and the Opposition leader on their able presentation of the present government...

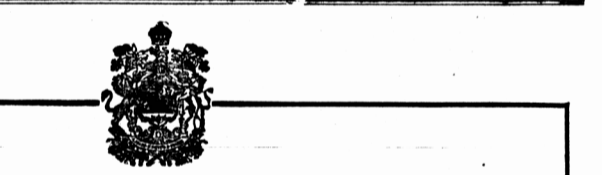

Guard Your Gasoline Ration Book

KEEP IT ON YOUR PERSON - DO NOT LEAVE IT IN YOUR CAR

NOW that you have your 1943-1944 gasoline ration book, it is up to you to keep it at all times in a safe place...

- 1. If, through negligence, you lose your gasoline ration book before October 1, 1943, you may be allowed no more...

The new gasoline rationing system, effective on April 1, will be strictly enforced. Under its provisions, the motorist, as well as the service station attendant, is held responsible if any infractions occur...

- 1. To purchase gasoline with 1942-1943 coupons.
- 2. To purchase gasoline unless you have the correct category sticker affixed to your windshield.

If you sell your motor vehicle, remember that before making delivery you must remove the windshield sticker or stickers. Remember also that after the sale is completed, you must mail to the nearest Regional Oil Control Office in your province the gasoline ration book or books issued for the vehicle.
