Stock Prices Easy In Light Trading Yesterday

NEW YORK, Feb. 2 — (AP)—Stocks had a difficult time keeping slightly ahead today in a market devoid of broad features. Interest settled in individual issues and in a few of the major groups. For the most part, however, prices were thoroughly mixed. Steels and motors took the lead early in the day when buying appeared in U. S. Steel, ex-dividend of \$2.25, and in General Motors, the third most active stock of the day. Steel fell back late in the day and closed off 1-8 at 75, while General Motors added 5-8 at 62 3-8. Most of the days losses were in the industrial issues. Oils lost their early gains and closed mixed. Airlines had one brief buying spur but ended with small fractional gains. Aircraft and metals were mostly lower, while Chemicals, rails and utilities were mixed but a bit higher on average.

At Toronto TORONTO, Feb. 2 — (CP)—Base metals, led by Consolidated Smelters, moved downward on the Toronto Stock Exchange today. Senior golds featured active trading to continue their advance for the third successive day. Western oils moved quietly on a slightly easier tone. Smelters dipped 3-4 at 108 1-4 in base metals and Noranda, Waite Amulet, Quebec and Hudson Bay were down fractions. Trading was active as Golden Bells, Noranda, Labrador and New Calumet dipped five to 15 cents. Lake Shore added 5-8 at 13 in the strong senior golds and McEwen, Hollinger and Dome showed small gains in moderate turnover. Several junior producers showed advances ranging up to five cents. Anglo-Canadian lost 20 cents at \$470 in an easier western oil list. Radio, Petroleum, Central Leduc and Calmont also dipped.

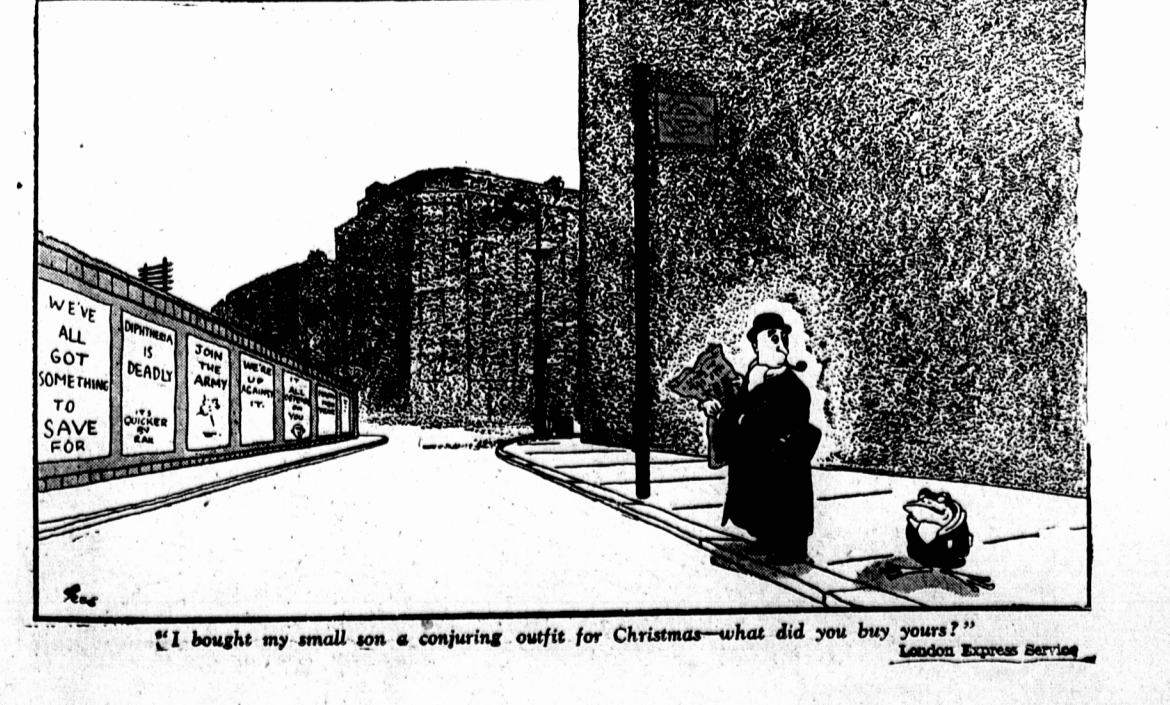
