CANTERBURY, Kent, England, June 15 (Reuters)—Prime Minister Attlee, without venturing any expression of confidence that world peace had at last been assured, grimly told a rain-drenched throng at a United Nations Association rally Saturday night that "the last war was ghastly enough but modern invention makes it certain the next one will be even more disastrous."

"It is no longer merely a matter of life and death of individuals—it is a matter of the life and death of civilization itself," Attlee declared.

He appealed for active support of all activities associated with the United Nations.

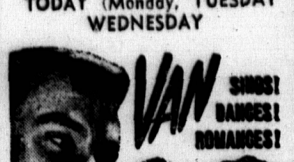
## Halifax Doctor Visits Patient On High Seas

Liberty ship Stanley Matthews to put a doctor aboard 840 miles east of Newfoundland.

## Congress Party Agrees To Division Of India

NEW DELHI, June 15 — (AP) — The All-India Congress Party agreed today to the division of India into Hindustan and Pakistan but served notice that the security of this great sub-continent will not permit the independence of the two new dominions.

The Congress is the dominant party in the area which will be Hindustan, the largest and most populous section of India, and its stand thus foreshadowed the policy of the Hindustan government.

It was an answer to an announcement by two of the largest princely states, Hyderabad and Travancore, that they intended to proclaim their independence when British power lapses in August.
