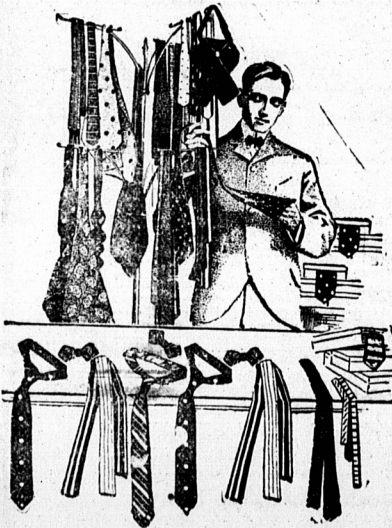

STORM IN NEW ENGLAND.

BOSTON, Dec. 10.—Although the coast storms which reached New England from the South, during the night, raged with great fury today, especially in Rhode Island and Southern Mass., comparatively little damage resulted, and the only serious marine accident was the springing of a leak of the Nantucket shoal light ship, anchored over two miles out to sea.
