By Frank MacMillen, Associated Press Financial Writer (By Guardian's Special Wire) NEW YORK, March 20.—The stock market saw-sawed gently today, and a little heaviness in the tobacco shares appeared to be enough to tip it downward toward the close.

Bonds on the whole behaved better than equities, with a number of secondary rails and utilities getting ahead fractions to a point or so. Cotton held steady and was no longer a primary influence in either direction.

Other news from the corporate front was indelible. The weekly review of the steel industry by "Iron Age" noted further small declines in the rate of operations and the level of scrap prices, and a slackening of forward consumer demand attributed to uncertainty created by the government attack on the "hanging point" system of prices now used in the business.
