Canada Mines Magnesian Dolomite

OTTAWA, March 31 — Outstanding developments in Canada's magnesian-dolomite industry during 1937 included the change over from open pit quarrying to underground mining, and the installation of a modern, high-temperature tunnel kiln for the making of basic brick at the property of the Canadian Refractories Limited at Killmar, Quebec. This new tunnel kiln, the fourth of its kind in the world, is 88 feet long and is capable of attaining a temperature of 3100 degrees Fahrenheit.

No magnesite, within the strict meaning of the term, is produced in Canada at the present time, and the Quebec deposits of magnesian dolomite are the only ones known in the eastern part of North America. Consequently they are favourably situated to supply the large markets for refractory products in eastern Canada and the eastern United States, and the overseas markets for magnesian dolomite have been extended to include Australia, South Africa and Great Britain.

For many uses these magnesian-dolomite products have proved more suitable than those made from magnesite. Products at present marketed include caustic-calcined magnesian dolomite, dead-burned magnesian dolomite, dead-burned shapes (both burned and unburned), and finely ground refractory cements. In combination with chrome, the dead-burned material is used as an ingredient in certain other types of refractories. Dolomite is also used for setting the bottoms of basic open-hearth furnaces and caustic-calcined magnesian dolomite is used in the making of floors and the making of floor tile.

Oysters In The Shell

Pay for a barrel of Canada's Atlantic oysters and how many oysters will you get? In quantity the buyer will obtain not less than two and a half bushels of oysters of legal size. The oyster inspection system administered on the Atlantic coast by the Dominion Department of Fisheries under the Fish Inspection Act seems to that. But what number of oysters will the barrel contain? Nature and the buyer's preferences both enter into the determination of the best. By very close grading it is possible for the oyster to weigh as much as 700 grams, but in a barrel most oysters are thick. Perhaps in most cases the barrel weighs 600 or 700 lbs. On the other hand, some buyers call for large oysters and the number in the barrel must necessarily decrease accordingly. Any number below 400, however, is unusual and the stock in cases of this kind is not likely to be equal in quality to shipments having higher counts to the barrel. Some shippers grade their output by count, as, for instance, one producing organization which last year set up three grades, one guaranteed 300 oysters to each barrel, another 200 and the third 100. Natural Mineral Phosphate

Numerous enquiries have been received recently by the Dominion Department of Agriculture regarding a fertilizer named "Natural Mineral Phosphate" which is being sold this spring in Ontario and the Maritime Provinces. This same product is being sold in the United States as Coloidal Phosphate. It is a by-product of the phosphate mining industry of Florida and contains its phosphoric acid in the same slowly available chemical form as natural rock phosphate.

Salmon Roe Production Doubled

Caviar, made from sturgeon eggs is the best known product of its kind, and Canada markets two or three thousand pounds of it every year, but the major use of fish eggs in the Dominion nowadays is in the preparation of salted salmon roe which is shipped, for the most part, to markets in the Far East. All of the salmon roe processed is packed in British Columbia and between 1933 and 1936 (final figures for 1937 have not been completed) there was a hundred per cent increase in the output.
