

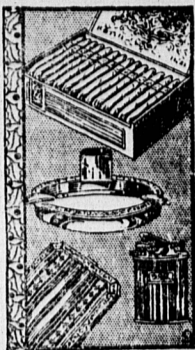

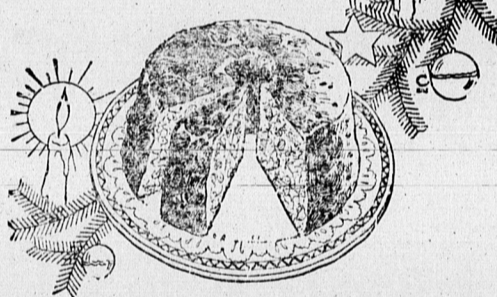

The dam of Legality is Rhein Lass, by Bingen. In this case Legality, 2:02 is an inbred Bingen. The second highest price paid at the sale was \$16,000 for Symphonia, 2:03, by Guy Axworthy, dam
