BRITISH NAVY IS TO HAVE BIGGER GUNS

Present Secondary Batteries of Fleet Not Regarded as Sufficiently Heavy — Japan and Russia are Making Provisions for Better Battle Ships.

LONDON, November 15.—The great question for which Lord Charles Beresford was invited to find a solution during the recent naval manoeuvres by the combined fleets in the English Channel and the North Sea was whether the naval battleships and cruisers were sufficiently armed to withstand an assault by torpedo boats, especially at night.

The reply of the admiral to this question I believe has been in the negative. Consequently some modification in the guns forming the secondary batteries of the newer ships will shortly take place. The guns now principally relied upon to supply this protection are handy little 12-pounders, which, however, are felt to be too light to stop a dash of this description.

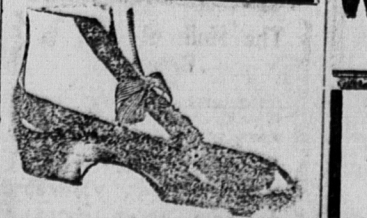
