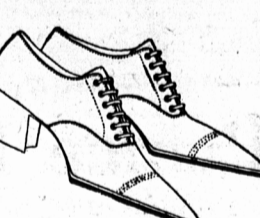

condition A large number of the airplanes are of the war type known as the "Bristol Fighters," which at the conclusion of the armistice, had the ascendancy over German "Fokker" machines. The German planes which will be sent to Canada are of the improved Fokker type and airmen declare that as airplanes they are not to be despised. They were flown by Canadian staff and in material, design and construction, were worthy to contest with the best allied planes.

The arrival of these flying machines in Canada is being eagerly awaited by members of the Canadian Air Force, many of whom were instructors in Canada during the war and have had little opportunity to study the best output of German airplane factories.

Some dirigible are also coming to Canada. They will not fly over but will be transhipped. Bess vessels will be needed to carry them across, air men state.
