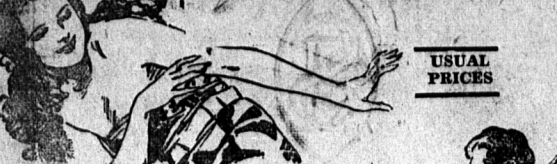

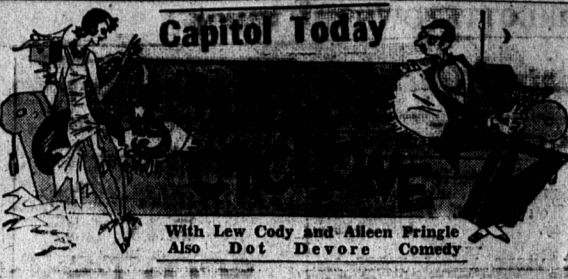

They are highly intelligent and seem delighted to bring their babies to be used in the various demonstrations. A Chinese woman, a student in one of the medical colleges, gave some of the instruction. The members had to be accompanied to and from their homes, as neither the women nor the children from the families were ever allowed alone on the street. Another interesting class was organized by Miss Goodman the supervisor, among the home girls in Clarkwood, and after several adjournments had been made, the nurse was able to teach them several helpful things. Many members of the class were the mothers of children, quite normal children, by the way.

Livestock Market

(Canadian Press) MONTREAL, Dec. 18.—There were 467 cattle, 207 calves, 1274 hogs and 889 lambs, for sale on the two markets. One car load of good cows and heifers were not sold at time of writing. The other cattle offered for sale were of common quality. Common to medium cows were sold for \$5.00 to \$8.50, canners and cutters from \$3.50 to \$4.50, bologna bulls from \$5.25 to \$6.25, according to weight. Grass calves were easier and prices ranged from \$6.00 to \$8.50. There were no top yearlings offered. Veals from \$12.00 to \$13.50 with about 400 lambs left over from yesterday. The lamb market was unsettled. Packers were offering \$10.00 and sellers were holding for better price. Hogs were steady; \$10.25 was the ruling price for good weight hogs fed and washed, flat with lighter hogs at \$10.00, sows were from \$8.00 to \$8.25 top \$8.50.

AMERICAN PRINCE IN FRANCE

PETROPOLIS, Brazil, Dec. 14.—Don Pedro Orleans, Braganza, last American Prince and eldest grandson of Dom Pedro II, last Emperor of Brazil, lives the life of a European country gentleman on his estates here, but at present spends much time at the Chateau d'Eu, in France where his five children are in school. His two brothers lost their lives in the world war, one as a flyer in the Royal Air Force, and the other from overwork and hardships in the French Red Cross. Son of that Princess Isabel who, while acting as Regent during Dom Pedro's serious illness, freed the slaves of Brazil in 1888, this Dom Pedro was born here in 1875 and by his grandfather was given the title of Prince of Gran Para which territory comprises the states of Para and Amazonas. Through his father, the Count d'Eu, near Newport in France. It is there he passes much time while his children are being educated. He is a grandson of Louis Philippe.

THE LIVERPOOL PACKET

"There's a saucy wild packet, a packet of fame. She's the Liverpool packet—O Lord let her go." HALIFAX, N. S., Dec. 14.—Outstanding in the wealth of marine history contributed by Nova Scotia sailing vessels is the Liverpool Packet, first a slave and later in the year 1812, a privateer, which according to a recent writer, "carried fifty prizes into port, revolutionized traffic along the Atlantic seaboard, started the project of the Cape Cod Canal, by her destructive raids, was captured, became a ghost, and came to life again as a still more successful privateer." After being seized for running contraband negroes into American ports the Liverpool Packet was auctioned off at Halifax in November of 1811 to Captain Bruce Collins. She had been a steamer to a larger Spanish slave ship and was very speedy, resembling a "Baltimore Clipper." Captain Joseph Barrs was her most famous master.
