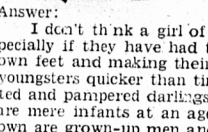

THE COOK'S CORNER

BUTTERNUT PIE
(One 8-inch pie)
One and one-third cups (1 can) sweetened condensed milk, 2 eggs, separated, 1 cup butternut meats or other nut meats, 2 tablespoons granulated sugar, unbaked pie shell (8-inch).

DATE MINCE MEAT PIE

(One 9-inch pie)
One package (9 ounces) dry mince meat, 1 cup pitted dates, chopped, 1-2 cups water, pie crust.

CHOCOLATE PIE

2 squares unsweetened chocolate, 1-3 cups (1 can) sweetened condensed milk, 1-2 cup water, 1-4 (teaspoon) vanilla. Baked pie shell (8 inch).
