STORM DRIVES SHIPS ON MOROCCAN COAST

CASABLANCA, Nov. 3.—(Special)—During the violent storm Sunday three vessels were driven ashore and wrecked on the Moroccan coast near this port, but their crews were saved, with the exception of eight men drowned by the capsizing of a life-boat. The vessels were the Greek Missolonghi, the German Martini, and the Spanish Lyria.

Another vessel, the French Transatlantic Company's Caravella, has a narrow escape. She suffered considerable damage, but was able to proceed on her voyage to Nantes.

A MILLION DOLLARS FOR GOOD ROADS

County Council of Essex, Ont., Presents By-Law for Improving 150 Miles of Roadway

One of the most important of the many road improvement plans now under way in various parts of Canada, is that just launched in Essex County, Ontario.

At a meeting of the Council, on Thursday, October 16th, a By-Law was drawn up for presentation to the voters next January. This by-Law calls for the raising of a million dollars to provide concrete roadways covering no less than 150 miles, and connecting all the important communities of Essex County. The proposed routes of the concrete roads will completely circle the County, and afford the finest type of highway connection to the farmers for reaching Windsor or any of the smaller towns.

With the assistance of Engineer Huber, of the Ontario Government, the committee appointed at the last

session of the council, went over the different roads proposed for paving. Basing this recommendation upon the fact that the route will be used for much heavy traffic, Mr. Huber made his report in favor of using Concrete throughout.

An interesting feature of the plan as outlined, is the provision of a continuous route of good roads. There have been instances in other communities where otherwise excellent road development ideas were, in a measure, spoiled by failure to have the good road a continuous good road. The Essex County Council have shown their wisdom and far-sightedness by providing for the complete connecting up of the proposed concrete stretches so that in the completed project will appear no interruptions of unimproved or bad roads. While not in a straight line, the completed series of roads will be, in effect, one long continuous highway all of concrete, and taking in practically the whole of Essex County.

There would seem to be a peculiarly enterprising spirit in the vicinity of the Detroit River. On one side of the River we have Wayne County, Michigan (the county of which Detroit is the principal centre) with approximately 100 miles of concrete County highways.

This magnificent series of highways has been a model for other communities, and has attracted visitors on inspection tours from all over the world. Now comes Essex County, a sister community, on our side of the river, with a plan which bids fair to fully equal that of Wayne County, and which will perhaps, eventually eclipse the splendid road system that in the pride of Michigan. The building of 150 miles of concrete highways such as Essex County is to have, means a model county in the viewpoint of inter-communication between towns. Doubtless we will find deputations of municipal officers visiting Essex County to obtain pointers on how best to link together the farm communities with the market places. The eyes of all North America will turn toward Essex County and watch with growing interest the completion of this project.

PAYMENT FOR VOTES SCIENCE IN CHINA

PEKIN, Nov. 3.—(Special)—The election of Yuan Shih-kai to the Presidency of the Republic of China afforded most interesting examples of what peculiar things can be done in a free and enlightened Republic—as this newest and largest aspirant to republican honors is called by the "heroes" who founded it.

The election of a Chinese President compares in no particular with a similar event in America. There is no stumping the country, no tearing round and whipping the citizens to a frazzle from the tail of a hundred miles an hour express; no sixteen speeches a morning by rival candidates; no popular upheaval; no "boozing." But there is abundant "hoodie." Payment for votes is reduced to a fine art, and the ostentatious display of force is reduced to a finer one. That is where the would-be President in China had the advantage if he happens to have been in power over the army.

The election which has just placed Yuan Shih-kai in the Presidential chair came ahead of the constitution which he swears to uphold. The committee which occupied the Temple of Heaven in its work of drafting a constitution was making remarkably slow progress when attention was conveyed to them at the instance of the President that it would be well if they first of all drafted the section dealing with the election of the President and postponed the remainder for a later day. The hint permitted of no evasion. It came just as Yuan Shih-kai arrived on top of the rebels and after the "heroes" had placed the Sea of Japan between themselves and what they had previously euphemistically described as "the greatest Republic on earth."

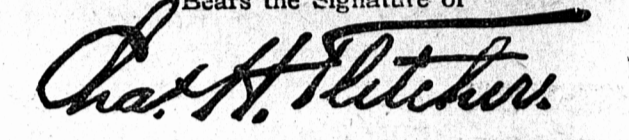

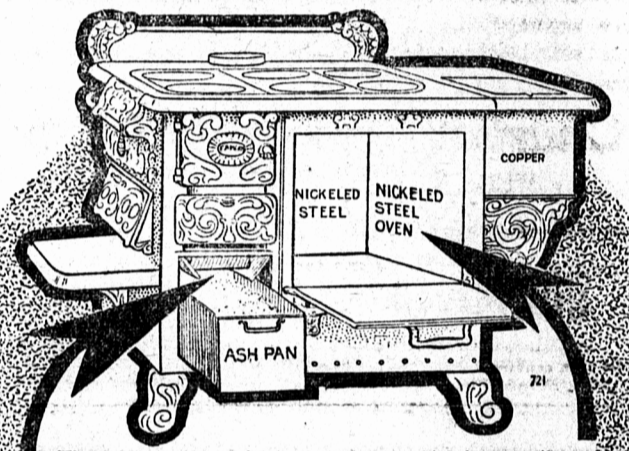
