NEW YORK, Sept. 28.—Marshall Field III, newly crowned, handsome namesake of the famed Chicago "Merchant Prince," and heir to his millions, has always had a soft spot in his heart for the British. He was educated in England, sporting "on the playing fields of Eton," and graduating from Cambridge University...

Comforts of Home

I., estate. From this 2000-acre place, Field often flies his plane to New York. It is the largest estate on Long Island. It includes a pink brick Georgian 60-room house, a 20-car garage, a private pheasant preserve, ample kennels, extensive stables (1000 and racinobies), tennis courts, and many beautiful gardens (which often take top honors at U. S. ranking lower shows).

He started his business career, not with his grandfathers firm, but as assistant to the head bookkeeper of a brokerage house. Because he felt he "lacked knowledge of military affairs," he enlisted as a private in the cavalry during the last war and came up through the ranks to a captaincy. For a short time after the war he returned to Chicago to help direct Marshall Field & Co. But normal business held comparatively little interest for young Field, and helping manage his grandfather's estate was a huge job in itself, moved to New York, and by 1935 he had given up his last active business interest (aside from a score of directorships—a partnership in a patent Chicago banking house he helped...
