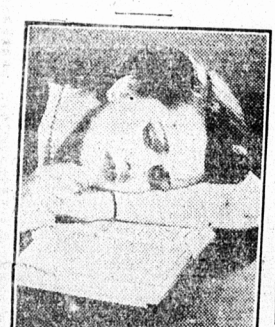

Household Scrapbook

Clean Fingernails Prevent staining underneath the fingernails by running the nails over a cake of soap before beginning a task which is likely to soil them. Rusty Steel It will be much easier to clean steel which has become very rusty if it is first rubbed with a cut onion and left for a day or two. Then polish it with paraffin, oil or turpentine and brush it, whichever you happen to have on hand. Never stir a salad. Merely toss it lightly together, blending the dressing thoroughly with each piece.

How Can I?

Q. How can I treat ferns that are infested with lice? A. Spray very thoroughly and repeatedly with nicotine solution. 'Black leaf 40' will give the directions for proper proportions. Q.
