Many Improvements Have Marked the Brief Ownership of Messrs. Foster, Bond & Co.

The purchase of the Dufferin Hotel by Messrs. Foster, Bond & Co. ushered in an era of improvement that has worked wonders. Altho' they have had but a few months of proprietorship so many and extensive have been the changes made that the hotel today looks like a new house. The room carpets have all been chosen with a due regard to the furnishings and so each room has a distinctive character. In many of the chambers handsome brass bedsteads and other modern furnishings have replaced the old-fashioned fittings. Some have mantle and folding beds that give them more the

appearance of parlors and sitting rooms. All are comfortable and cosy and there is not in the whole house a room but will prove satisfactory to any traveller, for all are airy, well lighted, well furnished and with a good outlook.

The main office, the main stairway, the dining room and the lavatories all received attention and today are bright in new paint, new ceilings and new furniture. In the office there was built a private room in which guests will find the stenographer and where they will be free of all interruptions, while transacting business. The lavatory with tiled walls and ceiling is probably the finest room of the kind in the city.
