THE JAPANESE LOST TRANSPORTS

May Delay Operations Against Port Arthur—Alleged Russian Cruelties—Their Heavy Losses at Vafango—Brief Review of the Military and Naval Situation.

THE LOST JAP TRANSPORTS. LONDON, June 18.—(Special)—It is believed the loss of the Japanese transports may delay the operations against Port Arthur.

ALLEGED RUSSIAN CRUELTY. The Russians permitted 610 non combatants to leave the Sado but there whereabouts is unknown.

HEAVY RUSSIAN LOSSES. The total Russian losses in their defeat at Vafango were about two thousand. There is no news of fresh fighting.

The events of the past week were the rail of the Vladivostok squadron southward, simultaneously with the

departure and return of the cruiser Novik from Port Arthur, showing that the harbor entrance there has been cleared; the destruction of two Japanese transports with, we know not how many troops on board, by the Russian cruisers, and the severe fighting on land at and near Vafango. The Oki Islands where the transports were sunk are over 500 miles south of Vladivostok, and not far from half way to Port Arthur. Evidently Admiral Skrydloff was maneuvering to get his two squadrons together. The incident serves to show that the Russian fleet is still to be reckoned with. The Japanese force which is moving northward along the railway line, driving the Russians before is said to consist of four divisions—at least 10,000 men, and much superior in number to Gen. Stakeburg's force opposing them. The Russian general having lost many of his guns, was at last accounts in some danger of being surrounded.

ELECTRIC CHAIR HORROR AGAIN

Negro Murderer Sustains Five Successive Shocks

Before Death Results—Later from the New York Disaster—Panic and Robbery at Circus in Chicago.

ANOTHER ELECTRIC CHAIR HORROR.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, June 18.—(Special)—The electrocution of Moses Johnson, the negro murderer today was almost as harrowing as that of Michael Schiller recorded yesterday.

TOOK FIVE SHOCKS TO KILL. The first shock failed to take effect, and five shocks were administered before the condemned man was pronounced dead.

In the Icy Waters of the Labrador Coast

News of Sad Fatality Reached Georgetown Yesterday. Capt. Henry Dicks and His Son the Victims.

News of a sad double drowning accident reached Georgetown yesterday. The telegram was from John Dicks of the schooner Julia A., now at Roman, Labrador, and read as follows:—"Father and Horatio were drowned on the 16th. Bodies are not found yet. Break the news to mother."

The men referred to are Capt. Henry Dicks of the William R., and his son Horatio, well known and respected residents of Georgetown. They left Georgetown for Labrador a few days ago on a fishing trip with two vessels. No word was heard from them until yesterday when the telegram above was received. No further particulars were given but details of the drowning are expected at once.
