THIS CRIMINAL A LITERARY MAN

Rare Genius Discovered in a Paris Fraud... Manuscript of Criminal Adventurers Found in His Room... Compare With Writings of Poe and Jules Verne.

PARIS, Dec. 7.—Literary genius has been discovered in a criminal named Sporn, who is on trial here for complicity in frauds. The police found in his room a manuscript entitled "The True Account of the Adventures of an Escaped Convict," which is such a thrilling and powerful narrative that several publishers are trying to buy the copyright.

Verne and Edgar Allan Poe. Sporn's escape was from exile in French Guiana, where as an habitual criminal he had been ordered for the rest of his life. He thus describes his preparations: "Good conduct caused me to be appointed a convict policeman to prevent my fellow-convicts fighting."

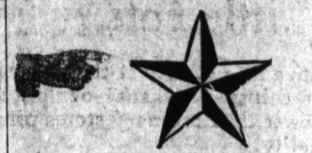

SALOON KEEPER SHOT TO DEATH

Assassin Fired Through the Window as Victim Was About Retiring

NEW YORK, Dec. 4.—Julian Salvatore, 35 years old, a saloon keeper, was shot and killed in his home early today by an unknown assassin. Salvatore, who had closed his saloon late, was about to retire with his wife and two children, when the murderer, shooting through a window, inflicted a death wound. The agonizing cries of the wife and children roused the neighborhood, but search for the assassin was fruitless. No explanation of the crime could be given by Salvatore's relatives except that he might have made an enemy in his business, who was unknown to them.
