TOMATO MINCE MEAT

3 lbs brown sugar
1 lb suet
2 lbs raisins
2 doz medium apples
1/2 lb citron peel
1/2 cup vinegar
2 teaspoons allspice
2 mixed spice
1 pk green tomatoes
1 salt
Put tomatoes through food chopper, and cover with cold water, let come to a boil and scald one half hour, then strain. Repeat above three times. Put strained tomatoes in stew kettle with all the other ingredients and let simmer one hour. Suet apples, raisins and citron peel must be put through chopper. This is a true and tried recipe and will keep as any mince meat, and is just as good, many preferring it because it is easier digested.

Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations

THE sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years of age may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency but not Sub-Agency on certain conditions. Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live with a nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader's good standing may be pre-empted on a good standing homestead. Price \$5.00 per acre. Duties Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 cents extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent on certain conditions. A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$7.50 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$500. The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions. W. W.
