DRUMS OF GAS ARE HURLED AT GERMANS

CANADIAN HEADQUARTERS IN FRANCE

Watchful waiting has for the moment followed the recent intense activity on this part of the front. The enemy clings most tenaciously to his cellars in Lens, despite the steady pounding of our guns and the frequent projection of gas. Early yesterday morning drums of gas were thrown into that part of the town in which the cellars are the most numerous. The Germans are morally afraid of gas in this form, and most of the prisoners taken (of serious losses from gas attacks. Despite these losses and the extreme difficulty of bringing food and ammunition into Lens, enemy working parties take advantage of every opportunity to repair their damaged positions.

A private of a Manitoba battalion who took part in the recent attack on Greca Crassier, and was wounded in the hip by an exploding bomb so that he could not walk, crawled into a shell hole well within the enemy's line, and lay there for five days without food before he was able to return to our side. He states that night after night enemy working parties were out repairing the damage done by our guns and trench mortars.

At a time when the German infantry is almost in revolt against their insufficient artillery support it is worth while noting that never before have the relations between the Canadians in the trenches and the gunners supporting them been so intimate. The corps commander has sent the gunners a message, through the general commanding the Canadian artillery, in which he praises their splendid work in the recent most successful operations, and adds that the assaulting infantry say that the artillery preparation has never been more complete, or the support better. S. O. S. calls were repeatedly answered within thirty seconds.

The success, the message concluded, must be ours when the co-operation between all the services was so marked, and the devotion to duty so outstanding. The strain under which the gunners have been carrying on their work since the battle of Vimy has been great, but it has been lessened lately. The review which was held two days ago, was followed by a march past of a greater number of guns and gunners than have been present at any similar event since the Canadian troops first came to France.

The pushing forward of our outpost line in the sector east of St. Laurent yesterday afternoon caused a heavy artillery retaliation which took the form of a barrage over a considerable part of our front, evidently in the belief that an attack was intended. During the night many flares were sent up, and the enemy talked a great deal in his sleep, but this morning (Friday) all is quiet again. A wounded officer was captured, together with two men in attendance, in the fight that followed the extension of our outpost line.

MANITOBA LIBERAL LEADER FAVORS CONSCRIPTION

Hon. Edward Brown, former leader of the provincial liberal party of Manitoba, and now one of the leading members of the Liberal government of that province, in an interview on the federal political situation, said:

"There is only one issue before the people now, and that is Conscription.

"This is no time for pussy-foot work or for hedging. The people must be either for conscription or against it. In my mind Sir Robert Borden is acceptable as a leader of a Union government, and I am not in sympathy with any attempts to drive a hard bargain at this time. Sir Robert Borden was the father of the Compulsory Military Service for Victory law and he is the logical leader of a Union government to carry it out. I would get behind a National movement with Sir Robert as its head.

"Timid, faint-hearted, war liberals" should ponder over the eighteenth verse of the fourteenth chapter of gospel according to St. Luke:

"They all with one consent, began to make excuses. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it. I pray thee have me excused. Another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them; I pray thee have me excused. And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come."—St. Luke 14-18.

"Too many war liberals resemble the several characters named in the parable. They could find a way of keeping the prime minister in a Union government, if they could bring themselves to place the war above political considerations. The excuses of those who insist on remaining out are not better than those of the men who rejected the invitations to the feast. They pray to be excused because other things interest them more than the welfare of the men at the front, the safety of the Canadian Nation, the integrity of the British Empire, and the cause of humanity. If war liberals are as anxious about the defeat of Prussian militarism as their public utterances would indicate, they will yet find means of joining Sir Robert Borden in the aggressive prosecution of the war. If they persist in hanging back the Prime Minister will have to go on without them. The greatest cause in all history cannot wait upon selfish politicians. The great mass of war liberals, regardless of their pussy-footing leaders, will unite with the Conservative party in strengthening the government's hands and in going to the assistance of the country's defenders overseas."

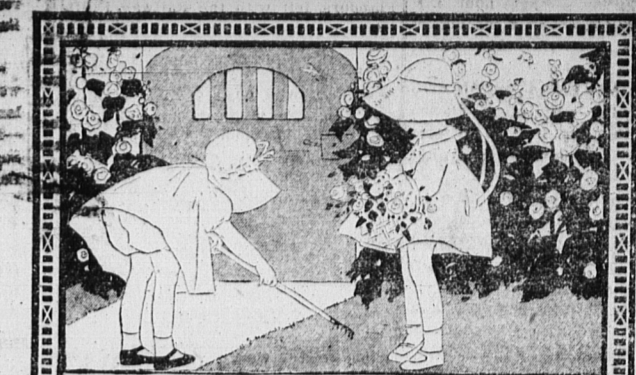
