MONTREAL, May 15 (CP)— Receipts on Montreal livestock markets today were 1,064 cattle, 1,765 calves, 2,510 hogs and 347 sheep.
 Good steers were \$6.75 to \$7.75, mostly \$7 up, medium steers were \$6 to \$6.75 and the bulk of the common from \$5 to \$5.50. Choice heifers made \$7, good \$6 to \$6.75, medium \$5.25 to \$5.75 and common \$4 to \$5. Good cows were \$5-25 to \$5.50. With the odd lot \$4.50 to \$5.75, medium cows mostly \$4.50 to \$5 and common \$3.50 to \$4.25. Canners and cutters were \$2.50 to \$3.25.
 Calves were steady to 25 cents higher. A few good veals made \$7 with medium kinds \$6 to \$6.50. The bulk of the calves were of common to just plain quality drinkers and veals were sold in mixed lots at \$4.50 to \$5. Very common light calves sold down to \$4.25.
 Spring lambs were \$4 to \$6 according to weight and quality. Sheep were easier at \$2.50 to \$3-50 with the bulk at \$4 to \$4.25.
 The bulk of the hogs were delivered on former contracts. One load of fresh hogs was sold at \$9 for bacon, fed and watered.
