HOUSEHOLD HINTS

The simplest thing for removing iodine from hands or white goods is household ammonia, which converts the iodine into iodine of ammonia.

If you have trouble with milk curdling when you put it on to boil try adding a liberal pinch of bicarbonate of soda to each quart of milk.

A drop of oil of cloves on the tongue takes away the sense of taste for a moment and disagreeable medicine can be given without any trouble.

Put a receipt for making plasters on your medicine chest door. It will be convenient in case some one unaccustomed to making them has to do so.

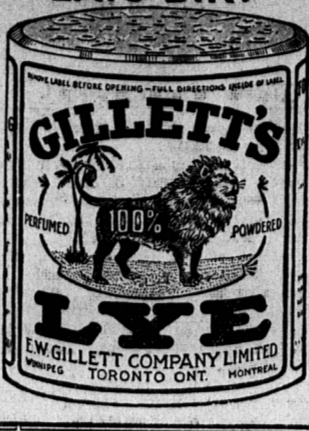
When a white enameled vessel has been discolored, simply fill the vessel with water and add a teaspoonful of lime. Let boil a few minutes.

A tablespoonful of Epsom salts added to one half gallon of cold water, thoroughly dissolved and poured over plant roots will hasten their growth wonderfully.

If part of a bottle of olives have been used to keep the remainder and a pinch of salt to the brine, pour a teaspoonful of olive oil in the liquid, and replace the cork.

In removing spots put a thick pad of cheesecloth or some other material underneath the spot to absorb the dirty cleansing liquid that soaks through the garment.

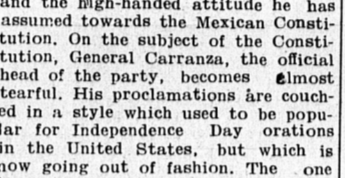

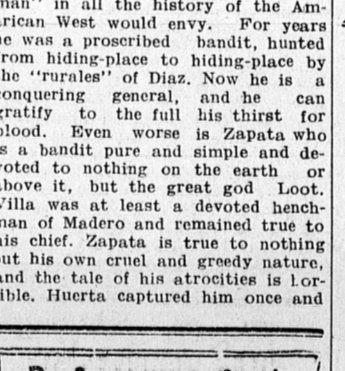

was on the point of making a sure and permanent conversion by the simple process of shooting him through the head. But Madero, with characteristic weakness, rushed into the camp, threw his arm about Zapata's neck, called him brother, and set him free. Mexico is now paying the penalty.

With every report that comes from Mexico, the tale of horror grows. Mere murder is a kindly thing compared to the barbarous atrocities that are constantly committed throughout the disturbed districts. Hideous mutilations, tortures, attacks against women, and the slaying of children are of daily occurrence. In view of such utter savagery as this, the burning and destruction of railway, mining and other properties, which is becoming general, seems a mere peccadillo. One is appalled at the thought of what is likely to occur if the Huerta government is overthrown, and such bandits as Zapata and Villa are free to harry and loot the country at their ease, and probably fight among themselves over the spoils.

It is impossible to say what the outcome is likely to be. In the end President Wilson's policy of procrastination may be justified. But in the meantime the responsibility for the terrible situation in Mexico lies largely at his door. If he had strengthened the hand of Huerta, much of this awful slaughter might have been avoided. And if the American policy has been dictated by considerations of oil-concessions and other commercial advantages, the responsibility is not only a heavy, but also a shameful one.
