
McGILL'S DEFICIT IS GROWING FAST.

MONTREAL, Dec. 20—That the annual deficit of McGill University has grown from \$12,965 in the 1907-1908 session to \$65,291 in the session of 1909-1910, is among the statements made in a strong presentation of the financial positions of the university in the annual report of governors, principals and fellows.

The report is made in accordance with university regulations to the Governor-General as a visitor of the university and is published by permission of His Excellency.

THE TURKEY DISEASE.

A new disease, called "blackhead" is spreading rapidly among the turkeys in Eastern Canada and in our middle west as well. It is an intestinal germ disease. The symptoms are a tendency to neglect its food, the loss of appetite, want of tone, and getting thin. The discoloration of the head, when it turns black is only the last stage of the disease, and it is then too late to effect a cure. General treatment is hard, but a prescription that has been found useful is sulphur five to ten grains, sulphate of iron one grain, mix to give in one dose. The dose should be administered two or three times a day for a good while before good results can be obtained. Such a dose is for a turkey weighing four or five pounds. Where the disease has taken a strong hold and become thorough, the whole flock without delay is the only remedy. When this is done, the roosts, food vessels, and all surroundings must be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected so that from a new lot of eggs—disinfected—may be obtained a new flock to be grown. The best disinfectant of roosts and localities, is a solution of carbolic acid, five parts to 100 parts of water. With this anything touched by the infected birds should be thoroughly sprayed. Indeed the same part of the farm where the infected birds have been, should not be used again for growing new birds.

A SUPREME COURT OF SCIENCE.

It is being maintained by some that two or three medical questions have become so important, that each nation should appoint a board of medical scientific specialists, to give authoritative decisions on disputed points. It is pointed out that through the agency of the Anti-Vaccination Society a widespread doubt has arisen as to the use of vaccination at all, particularly as it is maintained that the average number of cases of smallpox is no greater than those killed by lightning. Those who speak thus hold that the wholesale inoculation of school children has danger connected with it, and that the most careful selection of competent judges should give a final deliverance on the matter. The question of vivisection is also one on which difference of opinion prevails, and some say that the same or a similar tribunal should give a decision on the matter.

ELECTRIC LAMP.

For more than thirty years since the invention of the carbon filament in the electric lamp, that lamp has chiefly held sway, but new lamps have been coming in gradually and lately in much abundance. The Arst electric lamp has been in use some thirteen years. The objection to it was the difficulty in lighting it. But it is said that this has been somewhat overcome. The Osmium lamp was next but it will only do for a low voltage. The same objection holds to the Tridium lamp. Graphitized filaments and as well those made of lamp-black are used and some still advocate them. The Tungsten lamp is greatly recommended; its manufacture is very complicated; but it works best with a low voltage. The best known arc lamp with metallic electrodes is now said to be the Magnetite lamp.

A MYSTERIOUS DISEASE.

In Freston, near Ipswich, in England, an alarming and puzzling disease has lately shown itself. A man, his wife, his two children, and the next door neighbor have all died from it. Dr. Bulstrode, the health officer, has reported on the matter. He states that in neighboring parishes a dead rat and also a dead hare had died from some disease of a very uncommon kind. He advises that no one in the district should touch rats, hares, or rabbits that had died a natural death. The health officer declares that the rodents of the district are certainly infected with a malignant disease.

This suggests to us the occurrence of a year or two ago of the infection of rats and other animals associated with them communicating the bubonic plague.
