**NORTH CAPE BRETON ELECTION RECOUNT POSTPONED.**

—SYDNEY, November 8.—The recount proceedings in the North Cape Breton election opened at Baddeck on Saturday before Judge McGillivray. Both Mr. McCormack and his lawyers, Mr. P. Duchesne and A. D. Gunn, returned to Sydney Saturday night. D. A. Cameron, counsel for McKenzie, objected to the recount on the ground that the objections taken as to the validity of his client's election were not sufficient. The lawyers on both sides disputed over points of law until a postponement was ordered by the judge. The proceedings will be resumed on Tuesday.
