### WANTS INFORMATION

LONDON, Aug. 27. Colonel Repington, the Times military expert says: "We are kept completely in the dark regarding the actual fighting and results at Mons. It is our share in the war to display patience but with the wires open between the army and London it is surely not too much to ask that the casualties suffered by our army on Sunday be made known to us within a couple of days. We hear the enemy is advancing but nothing more. There the question is again of reinforcements. The right place for reinforcements is with our field army for here is the decisive point. No detachment or secondary missions can be anything but mischievous. Our army has a big job on hand and anything that we can spare, consistent at ways with security at home, should

be sent to Sir John French by the quickest route.

Japan is clearing the Germans out of Kia Chau in co-operation with us and sweeping the Eastern Seas of German commerce-raiders. A Japanese Alliance with us, and her participation in the war has had one important result, namely, that they set free all the five Siberian Army Corps of Russia for service in the West.

Russian has a quarter of a million men in Eastern Asia and Turkestan. Nearly all these on ground and with some eight more to come up, Russia is making the most mighty effort on her history. Since 1812 never surely was Russia so united, or her great people so determined to win. It is a nation on the march. When the Cossacks' lance touches Bradenburg Gate, and not before, peace will return to Europe. Distracted by the din of arms the German first army corps and two other reserve army corps have been heavily defeated



and driven into Koenigsburg where they will soon be shut up and closed in. Invested on the land side they may still be reinforced from the sea. The capture of Koenigsburg will consequently be an arduous task but it will surely be accomplished if all goes well. Before long East Prussia, East of the Vistula, will be in Russian hands and the attack on German fortresses on the Lower Vistula will begin. Not until the Austrian Army has been closely tackled can the Russian advance upon Berlin be safely made in its progress to the far West. But ample troops will soon be available for both objects.
