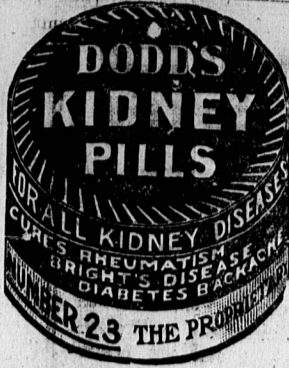

RECORD FOUNDRY HAD GOOD YEAR

MONCTON, N. B., Feb. 3 - At the annual meeting of the Record Foundry Machine yesterday afternoon the annual report showed a surplus of \$16,000, a fairly prosperous year. The earnings were double that of last year.

A feature was the development of the firm in the Canadian West, and the shareholders now feel that Western business has passed the experimental stage. Upwards of seventy carloads of stoves have been shipped west during the past year.

SHAUGHNESSY BACK IN MONTREAL

MONTREAL, Feb. 6 - Sir Thomas Shaughnessy, president of the C. P. R., who returned today from England, gave an emphatic denial to a rumor cabled from London that change was impending in the personnel of the C. P. R. steamship management.

It had been reported that Arthur Piers, manager of the C. P. R. steamship service, was to resign, and his place would be taken by Hugh A. Allen, with the title of fifth vice-president of the C. P. R. Sir Thomas denied this emphatically, saying that Hugh A. Allen had no connection with the C. P. R. and so far as he knew there was no prospect that he would.

The whole city is laughing at the precipitate retreat of Senator Casgrain after the crushing defeat of his majority aspirations. When it was seen that his defeat was certain last night he vanished and could not be located, while his headquarters were closed. He was finally discovered today in the seclusion of the senate chamber at Ottawa, but refused to discuss the election.

AGAINST RECRUITING FOR NAVY IN NEW YORK SCHOOLS.

ALBANY, N. Y. Feb. 3 - Dr. Andrew S. Draper, state commissioner of education, today made public a letter he is sending to superintendents and school commissioners throughout the state in which he says he has declined the request of an officer of the United States navy, engaged in recruiting service, who asked for a letter of introduction to school teachers, to assist him in reaching the young men of the state.

REPRESENTATION ON RAILWAY COMMISSION.

ST. JOHN, Feb. 5 - Train Despatcher Brassard, of Riviere du Loup, is reported to have been appointed to I. C. Railway Commission in place of Mr Butler, resigned. The announcement was made yesterday and has been received with surprise by the employees. Mr Brassard has not been connected with the I. C. R. for many years. He is French-Canadian.
