Like hay fever, asthma is not caused by the pollen of plants conveyed by bees or other insects. It is caused in some cases by wind-borne pollen. Inherited sensitivity, as in hay fever, is also the bottom of it.

There are people who cannot eat strawberries or some other foods without getting a skin rash, and there are people who have a rash or eczema as a result of eating certain kinds of food.

The windborne pollen of plants, foods, food dusts, face powders, dandruff, and feathers, especially those from ducks, turkeys, chickens and geese, people whose asthma is due to feathers usually show attacks of asthma early in life.

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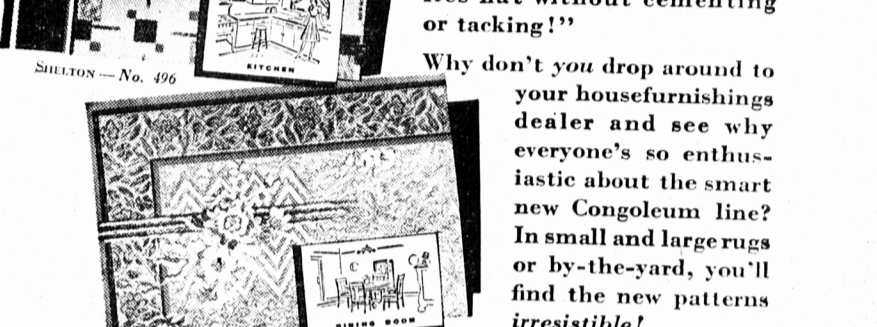
